66. TRADE LICENCES.

Board checked the list of unserviceable articles & after a long discussion, resolved to dispose off the above unserviceable articles by public auction.

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68. REHRIS.

Reference Motion No.09 dated 30.06.2008.

To consider the application dated 26.07.2016 received from Sh.Gurdev Singh S/O late Sh.Mangal Singh, resident of Village Thari for permission for sale of Biscuits, Namkeen, Toffee & Frooti etc. etc. on mobile reharhi.

The Board vide its Motion under reference decided to allow 25 rehris upto 31.03.2010. At present only 16 mobile rehris are being run in the Cantonment area. The above application is placed on the table. The Board may consider further action in the matter.

68. RESOLUTION.

The Board considered the matter & resolved to grant permission to sale the Biscuits, Namkeen, Toffee & Frooti etc. on mobile rehri only on usual payments. The Board further resolved that no subletting will be allowed and the allowed rehri will have to maintain hygienic necessities.

69. APPEAL U/S 340 OF THE CANTTS. ACT, 2006.

To consider appeal dated 09.05.2016 against the notice issued u/s 252(2) of the Cantts Act, 2006 vide letter No.CBS/10/297/-158 dated 25.04.2016 preferred by Sh.Arvind Kumar Sh.Late Madan Gopal R/O House No.297, Subathu Cantt.

The area measuring 590 sft. Comprising Sy.No.82/358, House No.297 is held on old grant terms in the name of L Bhagwan Dass. The property is situated within the notified bazaar area under the management of Cantonment Board.

Sh.Arvind Kumar S/O Late Sh.Madan Gopal constructed a over hanging projection over public street Sy.No.82/1 at second floor of property No.297 towards Southern side of the property in question. A notice u/s 247 of the Cantts Act, 2006 was issued vide letter No.CBS/10/297/-134 dated 06.04.2016, which has been replied by the appellant vide his application dated 11.04.2016 since the reply was not satisfactory & justified, therefore notice u/s 252 (2) of the Cantts. Act, 2006 was issued vide letter No.CBS/10/297/-158 dated 25.04.2016. Against which Sh.Arvind Kumar S/O Late Sh.Madan Gopal has preferred an appeal before the President & Cantt. Board Subathu dated 09.05.2016.

The parawise comments on the appeal alongwith connected documents are placed on the table.

The Board may consider further action in the matter.
