34. BUDGET ESTIMATES.

To consider and approve the Budget Estimates for the year 2014-15 (Revised) and 2015-16 (Original) as required under Rule 16 (1) of the Cantonment Account Code, 1924 alongwith the estimates of stores under Rule 68 (1) ibid.

All relevant papers are placed on the table.

34. RESOLUTION.

Considered and approved. It is resolved to forward the Budget Estimates for the year 2014-15 (Revised) and 2015-16 (Original) seeking ordinary grant-in-aid of `3,93,40,188/- only and special grant-in-aid of `1,75,00,000/- only for the year 2014-15 (Revised) and ordinary grant-in-aid of `4,23,32,722/- only and special grant-in-aid of `1,75,00,000/- only for the year 2015-16 (Original) to the GOC-in-Chief, Western Command for sanction.

The estimates of stores required during 2014-15 (Revised) and 2015-16 (Original) are approved.

The CEO is authorised to incur the expenditure in connection with typing/binding of Budget Estimates.

35. NOC REGARDING INSTALLATION OF DEEP BORE HAND PUMP AT SUBATHU -NEAR MASJID GATE: RECONSIDERATION IN PUBLIC INTEREST.

Reference CBR No. 29, dated 30-07-2014.

2. To re-consider the matter as resolved vide CBR under reference, in public interest.

3. As per the earlier precedents, the funds from outside sources allocated for specific purposes in the Cantt. Board area were vested directly with the Cantt. Board Subathu, following which the CBR No. 29, dated 30-07-2014 was passed. However, in the matter of installation of handpumps, the executing agency in Subathu Cantt. has been the I&PH Department. Also, the funds allocated for the said handpump under consideration are already lying with them (vested directly by the DC, Solan vide letter No. PLG/I-2/2014-75131, dated 05-07-2014). Therefore, in public interest, the Board, in partial modification and continuation of CBR under reference, may consider to grant "conditional permission" to I&PH Department to install the handpump near Masjid Gate. The likely benefits are:-

- i) Deputy Commissioner has already vested the funds with the I&PH, Division for the said purpose;
- ii) The expenses of deposit work will be saved;

- iii) There exists a precedent that all the existing handpumps in Subathu Cantt. area have been installed by I&PH Department and they have the technical expertise of the said job;
- iv) An asset for public will be created without any financial loss to the Board, without any rule being violated and by avoiding inconvenience or delay caused to the public;
- v) The complete ownership of the asset will be of the Board.

4. The conditions can be on the following lines:-

- a) The I&PH Division, Arki will install the said handpump out of its own expenditure;
- b) After installation of the handpump, they will unconditionally and irrevocably hand over the complete asset to the Cantt. Board Subathu;
- c) They will not have/claim any right whatsoever on the land beneath. The entire asset including the handpump will belong to Cantt. Board Subathu;
- d) Periodic maintenance responsibility remains with I&PH Department;
- e) Boring/installation of above pump will be carried out in the presence of JE of this Board;
- f) The exact site of the handpump has to be specified by the I&PH Department.

All relevant documents are placed on the table.
